The Privates Rule Workshop: Realistic Strategies to Prevent Sexual Abuse



With Dr. Nora Shine
Child and Family Psychologist

In this workshop, Dr. Shine draws upon her 20 years of experience as a child and family psychologist, her knowledge of evidence-based sexual abuse prevention strategies, and her own experience as a parent. The result is a set of research-driven, realistic strategies that parents, caregivers, and educators can use to prevent sexual abuse of children.

Dr. Shine's workshops are intentionally warm and engaging to reduce the anxiety associated with this topic. Participants will feel empowered as they learn:

- Facts about child abuse and effective prevention strategies
- Ways to recognize and confidently address adult behaviors that raise concern
